Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They began as a small machine shop initially employing 4 individuals. Sales for their first year of operation totaled sixty thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Throughout five years of operation, the business had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is one of the leading international producers within the material handling industry.

Design and production of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young company to aggressively pursue new business possibilities. All through the final sixty years, the trade of material handling has grown into a very sophisticated area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and numerous related products. The business feels certain in their capability so as to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's needs in the future and remaining aggressive within the world market.

In the 1950's, Cascade began designing, manufacturing and promoting hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was completed in the year 1956 on a brand new facility to be able to house all of the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total workers reached 180 employees and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the global world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

In 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the company has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental US to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are fabricated worldwide due to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is designed to be the essential customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the impressive acquisition of 5 companies, including the worldwide best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
